RECOMMENDED ACTION BY CITY COUNCIL

Staff recommends the following action:

"I move to approve the acquisition of the following Temporary Construction Easements (TCEs):

- a) APN: 020-061-22 (176 Hardie LN), Evans, in the amount of \$1,000
- b) APN: 020-061-21 (170 Hardie LN), Bridgewater Investments, LLC, in the amount of \$1,000
- c) APN: 020-061-20 (150 Hardie LN), Singh and Grewal, in the amount of \$1,000
- d) APN: 020-061-23 (180 Hardie LN), Bush and Donohue, in the amount of \$1,000
- e) APN: 020-041-64 (100 Hardie LN), Palmer, in the amount of \$2,000
- f) APN: 020-082-19 (355 Hardie LN), Sagar Energy Corp., in the amount of \$1,000"

Key Points:

- 1. These easements are necessary to complete proposed Hardie Lane Reconstruction Project improvements.
- 2. A TCE is being requested for each property listed above, to allow for grading and construction of driveway transitions. One of the six (6) properties listed also includes a TCE to allow for removal of a fire hydrant and water meter.
- 3. Property Owners have reviewed individual Summary Waiver Valuation Reports, and have executed proposed Agreements.
- 4. All proposed Hardie Lane Reconstruction Project acquisitions will be agendized for Council review.

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

Not all projects can be constructed within the limits of the existing right-of-way owned by either the Local Public Agency (LPA) or NDOT. In those cases, right-of-way must be acquired to accommodate the project.

Per the 2010 NDOT LPA Manual 6.3.5.1, "Appraisals shall be performed by state licensed appraisers under contract with the local public agency. Contract appraisers must be on the NDOT Approved Appraiser List maintained by the NDOT Right-of-Way Staff Specialist for Appraisals. Appraisals for property must follow the Uniform Standards of Professional Appraisal Practice and the Uniform Appraisal Standards for Federal Land Acquisition (Yellow Book). When differences occur between the two standards the Yellow Book shall be considered the prevailing authority.... Where property acquisition is uncomplicated and value is estimated to be less than \$10,000 the local public agency may prepare a Waiver Valuation according to the guidelines found in the NDOT Right-of-Way Manual."

The valuation for the parcels listed above were determined to be uncomplicated and fair market value was estimated under the valuation limits set forth in 49 CFR, Part 24, Subpart B, therefore, a Waiver Valuation was prepared by the City's ROW Project Manager of Atkins North America, Inc. After review of the valuations NDOT ROW concurred that these six (6) Waiver Valuation Reports were prepared under the appropriate State laws, regulations, policies and procedures.

The property Owners have met with the City's Senior Right-of-Way Agent to review individual offers and execute Agreements. Council approval of acquisition terms and costs will allow Staff to move forward with the payment of fees and finalizing Agreements. The City will need to complete these acquisitions in order to submit documentation to NDOT for the ROW Certification process prior to the Project going out to bid for construction.

BACKGROUND INFORMATION

Waiver Valuation Reports for the proposed acquisitions included in this Agenda Report were prepared by the City's ROW Project Manager of Atkins North America, Inc., using the NDOT ROW Manual guidelines. Additionally, the Appraisal Waiver process is set out in federal regulations 49 CFR, Part 24, Subpart B.

Just Compensation Memos, prepared by NDOT, outline the determination of the Just Compensation for the acquisition.

Just Compensation for the seven (7) proposed TCEs are summarized as follows:

APN: 020-061-22 (176 Hardie LN), Evans:

- Temporary Easement for Construction (TCE):
 - o 79 sq. ft., valued at approximately \$46.00, \$1,000 minimum applies

APN: 020-061-21 (170 Hardie LN), Bridgewater Investments, LLC:

- Temporary Easement for Construction (TCE):
 - o 62 sq. ft., valued at approximately \$36.00, \$1,000 minimum applies

APN: 020-061-20 (150 Hardie LN), Singh and Grewal:

- Temporary Easement for Construction (TCE):
 - o 759 sq. ft., valued at approximately \$440.00, \$1,000 minimum applies

APN: 020-061-23 (180 Hardie LN), Bush and Donohue:

- Temporary Easement for Construction (TCE):
 - o 172 sq. ft., valued at approximately \$132.00, \$1,000 minimum applies

APN: 020-041-64 (100 Hardie LN), Palmer:

- Temporary Easement for Construction (TCE1):
 - o 58 sq. ft., valued at approximately \$74.00, \$1,000 minimum applies
- Temporary Easement for Construction (TCE2):
 - o 207 sq. ft., valued at approximately \$260.00, \$1,000 minimum applies

APN: 020-082-19 (355 Hardie LN), Sagar Energy Corporation:

- Temporary Easement for Construction (TCE):
 - o 114 sq. ft., valued at approximately \$66.00, \$1,000 minimum applies

Section 5.378 of NDOT's (ROW) Manual requires the Minimum Allowable Payment for an acquisition to be \$1,000.00. Therefore, the TCE's listed above are rounded up to a value of \$1,000 each.
