AGENDA ITEM: (Possible action) Approve the award of 2020-2022 Water Treatment Plant Residuals Solids Removal Contract to Clean Harbors Environmental Service in amount not to exceed \$0.37 per gallon.

Agenda Item Brief: This is a contract to collect and dispose of residual solids generated from the treatment process from the Water Treatment Plant. This contract is renewed on a biennial basis and helps the city secure prices for the year and allow more accurate budgeting. This contract was advertised for bid in accordance with NRS and one bid was received.

BACKGROUND:

This is a biennial contract award for the removal of residual solids generated by the treatment of potable water at the City of Fernley Water Treatment Plant. The scope of this contract will include collecting the residuals out of holding tanks at the Water Treatment Plant and hauling the liquid containing approximately 2% solids to Lockwood Landfill for disposal. Clean Harbors Environmental Service will handle all permitting and costs associated with disposal (dump fees, environmental fees, etc.) which is included in their all-inclusive cost of \$0.37 per gallon.
