PROJECT SUMMARY:

Fernley Dental Specialties is seeking a will-serve for .23 water ERC’s and 1.27 sewer ERC’s to be used for tenant improvements.

Pursuant to FMC 32.39.060(a), commercial properties where the calculated ERC is less than 0.5 may pay a fee in lieu of dedication of a water right. The in lieu of fee for the requested will-serve is \$2,002.00. The water connection fee is \$1,187.95 and \$4,411.98 for sewer connection which will be required to be paid before issuance of the will serve commitment.

Fernley Dental Specialties is seeking a will- serve to add an addition to their current dental office for more bays and offices.
