**AGENDA ITEM: Staff Report (For Possible Action): For Possible Approval of a subrecipient agreement between the City of Fernley and Lyon County to use the CARES Act Funding monies for public safety and emergency response personnel salaries and benefits presumed to be substantially dedicated to fighting COVID-19 in the amount not-to-exceed \$320,000.00.**

**Agenda Item Brief: Lyon County is requesting CARES funding to cover eligible cost in response to COVID-19. Lyon County public safety and emergency response personnel salaries and benefits that were significantly dedicated in addressing needs and the effects of the COVID-19 pandemic, for the period from March 1, 2020 through July 31, 2021 will be covered in the subrecipient award.**

**"I move to approve the subrecipient agreement between the City of Fernley and Lyon County to use coronavirus relief fund monies from the CARES Act for public safety and emergency response personnel in the amount not-to-exceed \$320,000.00."**

**SUMMARY:**

City of Fernley has received CARES funding from the State of Nevada as a passthrough from the federal government to respond to the public health emergency with respect to the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19). Lyon County has had to modify normal operations to respond to COVID-19. These modifications include public safety/emergency response personnel presumed to be substantially dedicated to fighting COVID-19. Lyon County is requesting CARES funding to cover eligible costs in responding to COVID-19. In consideration of the foregoing premises, the parties would like to use the CARES funds to cover the costs.

**LEGAL IMPLICATIONS:**
